Associate Membership

Rules and Regulations

- ★ An Associate Membership at the Hyannis Yacht Club entitles the Member to the full use of the Captain's Table dining room and Captain's Table social activities.

 Reciprocity to other non-local private clubs may also be available. The privileges do not extend to any other part of the building, grounds, beach, or patio.
- ★ An Associate Member may bring guests to the Captain's Table. A member must accompany her/his guests.
- ★ A member must use her/his membership card to gain access to the premises and present the card to the server.
- ★ Associate Members do not have voting privileges. Membership may be revoked, with or without cause, at any time at the sole discretion of the Hyannis Yacht Club Board of Trustees.
- ★ A member is not allowed to bring alcoholic beverages into the Club House. Gambling is not permitted on the premises.
- ★ Only service dogs, as permitted by law, are allowed in the Clubhouse. https://www.mass.gov/service-details/about-service-and-assistance-animals.
- ★ Minors are welcome to dine anywhere in the restaurant, except they are not allowed to be seated at the bar.

The Captain's Table has a dress code:

AT ALL TIMES

- ★ Shirts and shoes are required in the Clubhouse
- ★ Gentlemen must remove their hats when in the Main Dining Room, Bar, and Deck
- ★ T-shirts and tank tops are not allowed in the Main Dining Room, Bar, and Deck
- ★ Ripped or torn clothing is not allowed in the Main Dining Room, Bar, and Deck

BAR AND DECK CASUAL DINING AREA

- ★ Comfortable casual clothing is acceptable. This includes collared shirts for men
- ★ Denim trousers or shorts are also allowed if neat, clean, and stylish
- ★ Rough work clothes are not acceptable

CAPTAIN'S TABLE MAIN DINING ROOM

★ Lunch: 11:30-4:00 pm

Stylish casual wear is required. This includes collared shirts and long trousers for men. Denim trousers or shorts are also allowed if neat, clean, and stylish.

★ Evenings

Long trousers (no denim) and collared shirts are required for men. Although sport jackets are not required, they are recommended. Stylish casual wear is appropriate for women. Dress shorts may be acceptable if neat, clean, stylish, and well pressed.

★ Holidays and Special Occasions

Long trousers (no denim), collared shirts and sport jackets are required for men. Stylish casual wear is appropriate for women. The attire for both men and women may be subject to change with specification on the event advertisement.

The Hyannis Yacht Club Board of Trustees has adopted the following rules:

- ★ Renewal dues notices will be sent on the first day of the yearly anniversary month of membership
- ★ Resignations must be made in writing 30 days prior to the expiration date of membership
